- Academic Strategies and Foreign Language classes
- Homeroom, Team, and House
- Bell schedule, movement from class to class
- Special education instructional classes and Co-taught services (reading, writing and math)
- May switch general education classes to receive services
- Teams provide different services and offer certain foreign lang. classes
- Student Support Center
